LBC- People of Praise p.3

Praise is the response of the Spirit to the revealed glory of God.

God's glory is His name, presence, and goodness, revealed to us in the face of Christ.

People of praise are those who know they have been redeemed, and are making it known!

Romans 5:6

⁶ For while we were still helpless, at the right time Christ died for the ungodly. ⁷ For one will hardly die for a righteous man; though perhaps for the good man someone would dare even to die. ⁸ But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. ⁹ Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from the wrath *of God* through Him. ¹⁰ For if while we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life. ¹¹ And not only this, but we also exult in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received the reconciliation.

Exultation in Christ is a "we" event- something we participate in together on the basis of our mutual reconciliation to God!

Psalm 51:12

¹² Restore to me the joy of Your salvation And sustain me with a willing spirit.

What do we do when the joy of our salvation is lacking, and we cannot find praise for God in our hearts?

Ephesians 5:18-21- walking as children of light

¹⁸ And do not get drunk with wine, for that is dissipation, but be filled with the Spirit, ¹⁹ speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody with your heart to the Lord; ²⁰ always giving thanks for all things in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ to God, even the Father; ²¹ and be subject to one another in the fear of Christ.

Hebrews 10:23-25

²³ Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful; ²⁴ and let us consider how to stimulate one another to love and good deeds, ²⁵ not forsaking our own assembling together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging *one another*; and all the more as you see the day drawing near.

It is nearly impossible to cast off regular fellowship with believers and to remain encouraged in faith.

God created us as a body, interconnected, interdependent- we cannot function normally in isolation. Psalms, Hymns and Spiritual Songs

James 5:13

¹³ Is anyone among you suffering? *Then* he must pray. Is anyone cheerful? He is to sing praises.

So, is anybody discouraged? Is anybody feeling like they are losing the fight of faith? We should pray!
