

The Truth: The Name that Releases Revelation

### Deuteronomy 5:24

<sup>24</sup>You said, 'Behold, the Lord our God has shown us His glory and His greatness, and we have heard His voice from the midst of the fire; we have seen today that God speaks with man, yet he lives.

### John 1:1

**1** In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

### John 1:14

<sup>14</sup>And the Word became flesh, and dwelt among us, and we saw His glory, glory as of the only begotten from the Father, full of grace and truth.

Jesus revealed the speaking God, whose name is the Word; through Him!

When we commune with God through Jesus, we are not only safe from death; we find Him to be the source of all life.

### Isaiah 30:19-21

<sup>19</sup>O people in Zion, inhabitant in Jerusalem, you will weep no longer. He will surely be gracious to you at the sound of your cry; when He hears it, He will answer you. <sup>20</sup>Although the Lord has given you bread of privation and water of oppression, *He*, your Teacher will no longer hide Himself, but your eyes will behold your Teacher. <sup>21</sup>Your ears will hear a word behind you, "This is the way, walk in it," whenever you turn to the right or to the left.

Communion leads to revelation; revelation means open ears hearing Him, and open eyes beholding the Son of God.

### John 16:12-15

<sup>12</sup>"I have many more things to say to you, but you cannot bear *them* now. <sup>13</sup>But when He, the Spirit of truth, comes, He will guide you into all the truth; for He will not speak on His own initiative, but whatever He hears, He will speak; and He will disclose to you what is to come. <sup>14</sup>He will glorify Me, for He will take of Mine and will disclose *it* to you. <sup>15</sup>All things that the Father has are Mine; therefore I said that He takes of Mine and will disclose *it* to you.

The truth He reveals is the truth about EVERYTHING. In Christ, all that God has is ours by the Spirit.

How do we receive revealed truth from Jesus?

### 2 Timothy 2:7

<sup>7</sup>Consider what I say, for the Lord will give you understanding in everything.

### 1 John 2:20-21

<sup>20</sup>But you have an anointing from the Holy One, and you all know. <sup>21</sup>I have not written to you because you do not know the truth, but because you do know it, and because no lie is of the truth

As I am seeking to know the truth about ANYTHING, I stop and consider, and He opens my understanding by the Spirit.

The result is sweet fellowship like that of a disciple with the Teacher, or the child with the Father.

2 things will sabotage this relationship like nothing else: pride of knowledge, and sanctimonious silence.

Here is the mantra of spiritual pride, just 2 words: "I KNOW"

### **1 Corinthians 8:2-3**

<sup>2</sup>If anyone supposes that he knows anything, he has not yet known as he ought to know; <sup>3</sup>but if anyone loves God, he is known by Him.

### **Ephesians 4:21b**

<sup>21</sup>...just as truth is in Jesus

### **2 Timothy 1:12**

<sup>12</sup>For this reason I also suffer these things, but I am not ashamed; for I know whom I have believed and I am convinced that He is able to guard what I have entrusted to Him until that day.

More than knowing why we believe what we believe, we need to know Whom we have believed.

Spirit of revelation in the knowledge of Him...

The second threat to communion with Christ is sanctimonious silence: the breakdown of your testimony out of judgmentalism or fear.

### **2 Corinthians 4:13**

<sup>13</sup>But having the same spirit of faith, according to what is written, "I believed, therefore I spoke," we also believe, therefore we also speak

The speaking God has speaking servants!

### **Revelation 19:10**

<sup>10</sup>Then I fell at his feet to worship him. But he \*said to me, "Do not do that; I am a fellow servant of yours and your brethren who hold the testimony of Jesus; worship God. For the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy."

### **2 Peter 1:20-21**

<sup>20</sup>But know this first of all, that no prophecy of Scripture is *a matter* of one's own interpretation, <sup>21</sup>for no prophecy was ever made by an act of human will, but men moved by the Holy Spirit spoke from God.

Seek Truth in Jesus' name. All the Father has belong to Him, and He is eager to reveal it!

Speak Truth in Jesus' name, and God will take you up, carry you along, and speak through you!
